On behalf of the men and women of the Peru Fire Department it is my pleasure to present our Annual Report for 2021. The purpose of this report is to offer a snapshot of the activities in which the fire department is involved. Within this report you will find many interesting facts, response statistics and data from the past year. We invite you to explore the information and take a glance at the comprehensive services we provide our residents, businesses and visitors 365 days a year.

In 2021 we ended the year in record fashion as we responded to a total of 390 calls for service. These calls for service include all types of fires, medical assists, vehicle accidents, hazardous material incidents, mutual aid requests, activated alarms and weather spotting.

2021 gave us a new twist as we had to respond to COVID-19. This pandemic has affected all aspects of emergency response, training, and response procedures. Keeping our first responders safe during this trying time has been a very large undertaking. While we did have several positive cases at the fire department we were still able to provide excellent service to our citizens.

Each year we are able to meet the challenges of an increased demand for emergency services because of the motivated and dedicated professional firefighters that strive to serve you each and every day. I would like to personally thank all of our personnel for their continued commitment of going "above and beyond" making the Peru Fire Department truly an exemplary organization.

Demand for fire and EMS service continues to climb yearly. We operate daily with 1 full time firefighter and 1 full time chief. We currently have 4 fulltime firefighters and 18 paid on call firefighters. Recruitment in the fire service is becoming a large problem as the lack of younger firefighters is dwindling. This is a nationwide problem. We continue to try and recruit daily.

In closing, I would like to thank the citizens, Mayor, and City Council for their support to allow us to serve the City of Peru.






