City Engineer Eric Carls provided the following project updates:

- 7th Street Water Main and Area 1 Phase 5
 - Both projects came in under engineer estimates and will be awarded to SKI Sealcoating & Maintenance
- Change order coming for the John Pohar and Sons contract for Midtown Road area project due to soil conditions and scope additions removed from the N. Peoria Road Project
- John Pohar and Sons to be finishing mass grading and base course from Midtown Road to Peoria Street for approximately \$60,000
- Change order will be required for Advanced Asphalt for the N. Peoria Road project due to scope changes to or the addition of adjacent capital projects
