CITY OF PERU REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING NOVEMBER 23, 2020

A regular meeting of the Peru City Council was called to order by Mayor Scott J. Harl in the Peru City Council Chambers on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari (remote), Waldorf (remote), Lukosus (remote), Radtke, Sapienza (remote), Payton (remote), Ballard (remote) and Buffo present; Mayor Harl present.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

PRESENTATION

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS/ACTIVITY REPORTS

Mayor Harl presented the minutes of the Regular Meeting of November 9, 2020; City Clerk's Report of Cash Received for October 2020; Sales, Home Rule, Use and Telecommunication Tax Receipts for August 2020; Treasurer's Report for October 2020 and the Peru Police Department Monthly Report for October 2020. Alderman Buffo made a motion that the minutes and reports be received and placed on file. Alderman Waldorf seconded the motion; motion carried.

Alderman Buffo made a motion that the report be received, placed on file and the bills be paid in the usual manner. Alderman Payton seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Radtke made a motion to renew contract with Key Benefits Administrators for 2021 selffunded health insurance with a total maximum funding of \$1,380,500.00 (stop loss carrier will be Symetra through Gallagher with KBA as the third party administrator)(employee funding based on expected risk). Kim Reese, Director of Human Resources noted a seamless transition and reduction of 11%. Alderman Payton seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Waldorf made a motion to approve quote from Clegg-Perkins for purchase of new traffic cabinet and related hardware for I-80/Rt 251 in amount of \$36,850.00 with said purchase to be reimbursed by IDOT pursuant to State/City maintenance contract. Alderman Lukosus seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Council discussed and was in favor of moving forward with current business expansion with potential request for upgraded transformer (City to purchase and reimbursed from customer).

Alderman Lukosus made a motion to execute an electrical engineering service agreement with BHMG for the Center Street Substation project. Alderman Waldorf seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Lukosus made a motion to execute a civil engineering service agreement with Chamlin & Associates for the Center Street Substation project. Alderman Ferrari seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert presented a proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING MEMBERSHIP IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION CONTRACT FOR A NORMAL GUARANTEED COST RMA ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION FOR 2021 OF \$422,183.00

Alderman Payton made a motion the ordinance be adopted as written and read. Alderman Sapienza seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley reported on the process of reviewing coverage with IMIC and IMLRMA. IMIC premium for 2020 was \$472,000. Clerk Bartley explained the relationship and service by IMIC has be excellent and having previously worked with IMLRMA they were also a great service provider and many of the same personnel the City would be working with again. Unfortunately, IMIC was not able to quote until after December 1st due to delays with their stop loss carrier. Clerk Bartley Recommended moving back to IMLRMA for 2021 with a guaranteed cost of \$422,183.00. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ferrari, Waldorf, Lukosus, Radtke, Sapienza, Payton, Ballard and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

The Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service responded to two hundred seventy-four (274) patient/calls during the month of October. The two hundred seventy-four (274) patient/calls included one hundred thirty-seven (137) emergencies for Peru, three (3) emergencies for Dimmick, zero (0) emergency for Peru Township, and one hundred sixteen (116) transfers. Of the one hundred forty (140) emergencies, ninety (90) patients were transported, forty-three (43) patients refused treatment, four (4) were disregarded, and three (3) were Standbys.

Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. responded to four (4) Mutual Aid requests with La Salle Ambulance, seven (7) Mutual Aid requests with 10/33 Ambulance, one (1) Mutual Aid request with Tonica Ambulance, two (2) Mutual aid requests with Princeton Fire/EMS, one (1) Speedway Standby request, and three (3) Motor Cross Standby request.

The total mileage logged was 14025 miles for the month of October.

Petitioner desires to resubdivide the Property and seeks approval of the Final Plat of The Pointe to the City of Peru, Illinois, consisting of eighteen residential lots. A copy of the Final Plat is attached hereto as "Exhibit A". Petitioner further requests the following waivers:

- (a) Waiver of all fees and impact fees including but not limited to, the plat review fee, the plan review fee, the construction inspection fee, water and sewer acreage fees, water and sewer front footage fees, and infrastructure construction inspection fees;
- (b) Waiver of the requirement under the Subdivision Ordinance that a Preliminary Plat be prepared and submitted for approval under Article III; and
- (c) Waiver of the requirement that a subdivision security be obtained from the subdivider pursuant to Article XII, Section 12.02 A of the Subdivision Ordinance.

The Property is zoned R-2 Single Family, Detached Dwelling District.

Planning/Zoning Commission Members Miller, Atkinson, Kalsto (remote via Zoom), Grabowski, Brady, and Moreno were present at the hearing. Member Lucas was absent. Due to COVID-19, this meeting was also streamed live on the internet.

Attorney Jonathan Brandt appeared on behalf of Petitioner and was duly sworn. Attorney Brandt testified that this is a proposed residential development with eighteen very affordable lots with an average sales price of approximately \$40,000.00. Pursuant to Petitioner's Development Agreement with the City, Petitioner is required to construct sidewalks, curb and gutter. The development is located north of the new round-about and south of the City's new police station under construction. There will be one point of access from 26th Street and will have a cul-de-sac. Attorney Brandt stated that Petitioner will work closely with the City pursuant to the Development Agreement and it will be a special development when completed.

In response to questioning from Member Brady, City Engineer Eric Carls confirmed that the proposed development will have a drainage pond to the south by the roundabout and landscape blocking on lots 1-5. In response to further questioning from Member Brady, Engineer Carls stated there is planned landscaping along the entire perimeter of the subdivision except lots abut 26th Street. There will be landscaping near the drainage and public utility easement around lots 6 through 10. The City is further planning to add landscaping on the outside of the new recreation trail.

In response to questioning from Chairman Miller, Attorney Brandt stated the subdivision will not be gated. In response to questioning regarding fencing from Chairman Miller, Engineer Carls stated that the decision to add fencing will be left to the individual lot owners, but his department is working with Petitioner to develop covenants and restrictions for the subdivision pursuant to the Development Agreement with the City to ensure continuity and aesthetics. There will be no chain link fencing allowed, for example.

City Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert then received a letter from Engineer Carls dated 11/30/2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit B" and entered it into the record. Engineer Carls recommended the P/Z Commission approve each of Petitioner's requests.


A call for public comment was made. There were no objectors online or in-person at the hearing.

The Planning/Zoning Commission found Petitioner's requests will not alter the essential character of the locality; will not be detrimental or injurious to other properties in the area; will not impair an adequate supply of light or air to adjacent properties, or increase the danger of fire, or endanger the public safety, or diminish or impair property values and will not increase street congestion and, therefore, recommends to the City Council that the Petition be granted.

Member Moreno moved, and Chairman Miller seconded, that the Petition as prayed for be favorably recommended to the City Council. The motion passed unanimously: 6 aye, 0 nay, and 1 Member absent.



AN ORDINANCE ABATING 2020 TAX LEVY AS PROVIDED BY GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2010, "RECOVERY ZONE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BONDS-DIRECT PAYMENT" BOND ORDINANCE NO. 4692 DULY PASSED AND ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 15, 2010

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2010, the City Council of the City of Peru, Illinois (hereinafter "City") duly passed and adopted Ordinance No. 4692 entitled: "ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TAXABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2010 (RECOVERY ZONE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BONDS-DIRECT PAYMENT) OF THE CITY OF PERU, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COSTS OF CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, PAYING FOR THE COSTS RELATED THERETO AND TO THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS AND FOR THE LEVY OF A DIRECT ANNUAL TAX SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS" (hereinafter "Bond Ordinance"); and

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ABATING 2020 TAX LEVY AS PROVIDED BY BOND ORDINANCE NO. 6487 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PERU, LASALLE AND BUREAU COUNTIES, PROVIDING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2020" DULY PASSED AND ADOPTED JUNE 8TH, 2020

WHEREAS, on June 8th, 2020, the City Council of the City of Peru, Illinois (hereinafter "City") duly passed and adopted Ordinance No. 6487 entitled: "ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PERU, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PROVIDING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2020" (hereinafter "Bond Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Bond Ordinance provides for the levy of \$607,612.50 for the tax year 2020 for the purpose of paying principal and interest on the bonds; and

WHEREAS, the City has available funds in the General Fund to make said principal and interest payment and the tax levy for 2020 as provided by the Bond Ordinance is unnecessary and may, therefore be abated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The levy of a direct annual tax in the amount of \$607,612.50 for the year 2020, as provided by the Bond Ordinance, is unnecessary due to presently available funds in the General Fund and, therefore, said levy may be, and is hereby abated, and the County Clerk of LaSalle County, Illinois, shall not extend said tax for the year 2020 as provided in the Bond Ordinance.

SECTION 2: The City Clerk of the City of Peru, Illinois, shall forward a certified copy of this ordinance to the County Clerk of LaSalle County, Illinois, immediately after its passage and approval.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage and approval.

RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT AND COMMITMENT OF LOCAL FUNDS FOR FEMA BRIC GRANT APPLICATION FOR WATER STREET ELECTRIC SUBSTATION RELOCATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Peru, Illinois is applying to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant funds to relocate the Water Street electric substation out of the Illinois River floodplain to prevent power interruptions to residents, critical facilities, and businesses during a flood event.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made and agreements be entered into with the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, criteria of FEMA BRIC are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with BRIC funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1) that the City of Peru apply for a grant under the terms and conditions of the State of Illinois and FEMA and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances contained in said application.
- 2) that the City of Peru has identified this mitigation strategy in the Community Risk Assessment to; 'relocate the City of Peru electric Water Street substation to a location outside the floodplain' in the 2020 LaSalle County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. Adopted on November 9, 2020 by the City of Peru.
- 2) that the City of Peru Mayor and City of Peru Clerk on behalf of the City execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said application.
- 3) that the City of Peru Mayor and City of Peru Clerk are authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
- that City of Peru does hereby commit funds for use in conjunction with a FEMA BRIC Grant, such funds to equal 30% of the estimated total project cost of \$7,273,908.49 or \$2,182,172.55. The funds will come from the City of Peru Utility Fund.
