CITY OF PERU REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MAY 10, 2021

A regular meeting of the Peru City Council was called to order by Mayor Ken Kolowski in the Peru City Council Chambers on Monday, May 10, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Waldorf, Sapienza, Lukosus and Buffo present; Mayor Kolowski present.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

PUBLIC COMMENT

PRESENTATION

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS/ACTIVITY REPORTS

Mayor Kolowski presented the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 26, 2021 1st Meeting; Regular Meeting Minutes of April 26, 2021 2nd Meeting; Special Meeting Minutes of May 5, 2021; General Fund and Miscellaneous Funds Report for March 2021 and Utility Fund Report for March 2021. Alderman Waldorf made a motion the minutes and reports be received and placed on file. Alderman Payton seconded the motion; motion carried.

Alderman Buffo made a motion that the report be received, placed on file and the bills be paid in the usual manner. Alderman Sapienza seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Waldorf, Sapienza, Lukosus and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Justin Miller, Director of Finance initiated a discussion regarding the City of Peru Economic Support program and stated there is \$45,000 left over from the program. Mr. Miller stated he re-applied for use of the funds and approval was granted, therefore, creating a City of Peru Phase II Economic Support program. Mr. Miller provided a handout explaining the criteria to be eligible for remaining funds. Alderman Payton made a motion to approve Phase II of Peru Economic Support Program Guideline and Application. Alderman Tieman seconded the motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Waldorf, Sapienza, Lukosus and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Waldorf made a motion to approve cost sharing quote with the Illinois Valley Pistol Shrimp from SportsField for field upgrades at Veteran's Park for \$13,700. Alderman Edgcomb seconded the

motion. City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Waldorf, Sapienza, Lukosus and Buffo voting aye; motion carried.

Police Chief Doug Bernabei reported replaced cars will be marketed for resale and got no offers. Chief Bernabei stated an interested community offered the city \$7,000 for a vehicle. Corporate Counsel will prepare a resolution for sale of vehicle.

PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE

PSM Jeff King reported on issues with two lift stations. PSM King stated the 30th Street lift station by Baker Lake is an emergency repair needing wiring and new pump at an approximate cost of \$12,000 and the Menards lift station suffered a main pump failure and running on a secondary pump.

PSM King reported on a aging X Mark mower for the parks department that needs to be replaced. PSM King stated he received a quote from Smith Services and Sales for \$16,184.00

PSM King reported on an issue with a basement backup on 26th Street between Rock and Plain Street noting the backup is due to diapers being flushed. PSM King stated they are going to canvas the neighborhood and remind residents not to flush anything besides toilet paper.

Alderman Edgcomb asked Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning to report on the standing water near the new police station. Mr. Carls noted the slow drain down due to EPA run off filters.

Mayor Kolowski proclaimed May 9-15, 2021 as National Police Week and May 15, 2021 as Peace Officers Memorial Day. Alderman Edgcomb made a motion the proclamation be received and placed on file. Alderman Buffo seconded the motion; motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

City Clerk Dave Bartley provided an on the more than \$70,000 in delinquent utility charges the city was owed as of last month. Bartley explain this issue has been talked about at council meetings over the past few months his office has attempted to give all residents with outstanding charges an opportunity to make payment arrangements. As of April 12, the outstanding balance was \$76,089, and as of April 30 the amount fell to \$73,667 and as of May 10 the amount was sitting at \$64,814. Clerk Dave Bartley reported 26 residents made no contact with the city, 13 have paid in-full, 24 have made payments along with making a payment agreement and 16 have made agreements but have made no payments. Clerk Bartley stated said all of these accounts have been receiving a monthly delinquent notice besides a three-month hiatus during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic. The council discussed and agreed a June 1st deadline is more than fair and residents have been given enough of an opportunity to respond, those who have made no effort to contact the city, if no such effort is made ad disruption in their utility services will be enforced.

Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning reported on the closure of the bridge to the Peru boat ramp. Mr. Carls stated the bridge is closed pending inspection by IDOT and closed originally due to failed inspection.

Pursuant to legal notice published in the News Tribune in the manner provided by law, the Planning/Zoning Commission of the City of Peru convened for a public hearing on Wednesday, May 19, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Municipal Building, 1901 Fourth Street, Peru, IL, to consider the Petition of Tiffany Eilers (hereinafter "Petitioner") concerning real estate located at 2926 7th Street, Peru, IL, legally described as follows:

LOT THREE (3) IN BLOCK ONE (1) IN TARA'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PERU, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED N PLAT BOOK "U", PAGE 62, AS DOCUMENT NO. 433898, SITUATED IN LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

PIN: 17-18-400-016 (hereinafter "Property").

Petitioner desires to construct a 24' x 24' addition to an existing 24' x 24' detached garage on the Property and requests the following relief, to wit:

- 1.) A variance from Sections 6.01.1(e) and 6.01.3(c) of the Zoning Ordinance to increase to maximum allowable ground floor area of all detached garages and accessory structures to 1,152 sq. ft.;
- 2.) A variance from Sections 6.01(a)(4) and 6.01.3(e) of the Zoning Ordinance to allow the total ground floor area of all detached garages and accessory structures to exceed 25% of the area in a rear yard; and
- 3.) For such other relief as may be equitable and just.

The Property is located in an R-3, Single-Family and Two-Family Residence District.

Planning/Zoning Commission Members Atkinson, Grabowski, Brady, and Moreno were present at the hearing. Chairman Miller and Members Lucas and Kalsto were absent. The meeting was also streamed live on the internet.

Petitioner Tiffany Eilers and her husband, Brian Eilers appeared and were duly sworn. Petitioner testified that they have been renovating the interior of the home and plan to replace the siding on the house and would like to expand their garage at the same time. Mr. Eilers stated that they own classic cars and the reason for the expansion of the garage is to store those cars securely indoors and out of the elements. There will be no business activities performed there.

In response to Member Atkinson, Mr. Eilers stated that he had spoken to his neighbors and they were all supportive of the proposed expansion. Mr. Eilers added that most of the neighbors around the Property have privacy fences. In response to further questioning from Member Atkinson, Mr. Eilers confirmed that access will be through the existing garage and no additional access will be provided from the rear.

City Engineer Eric Carls stated that his office had inspected the Property and that he did not believe the addition would compromise the aesthetics of the neighborhood. This is simply a depth addition and would not change the appearance of the garage from the street. Engineer Carls favorably recommended approval of the petition.

Mr. Eilers added that they recently cut down a huge elm tree on the Property that, if it had fallen, would have damaged a considerable amount of surrounding property.

Member Grabowski complimented and thanked Petitioner for the amount of detail provided in the Petition. In response to questioning from Member Grabowski, Mr. Eilers confirmed that they would be removing the back wall of the garage and continuing the 4/12 pitch roof line. The roof trusses are being made by Walnut Custom Homes in Walnut, IL.

There were no objectors online or in-person at the hearing.

The Planning/Zoning Commission found the requested variances will not alter the essential character of the locality; will not be detrimental or injurious to other properties in the area; will not impair an adequate supply of light or air to adjacent properties, or increase the danger of fire, or endanger the public safety, or diminish or impair property values and will not increase street congestion and, therefore, recommends to the City Council that the Petition as prayed for be granted.

Member Grabowski moved, and Member Atkinson seconded, that the Petition as prayed for be favorably recommended to the City Council. The motion passed unanimously: 4 aye, 0 nay, and 3 Members absent.

- (2) A variance from Sections 6.01(a)(4) and 6.01.3(e) of the Zoning Ordinance to allow the total ground floor area of all detached garages and accessory structures to exceed 25% of the area in a rear yard; and

ZUKOWSKI (hereinafter "Grantors"), for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the **CITY OF PERU**, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation, its successors, permittees, and assigns (hereinafter "Grantee"), the following perpetual rights and easements:

To construct, operate, repair, maintain, patrol, inspect, relocate, reconstruct, and remove from time to time sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and a drainage system and any and all manholes, tiles, pipes, connections, catch basins and, without limitation, such other installations as may be required or may be deemed necessary by Grantee for sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and/or drainage system purposes,

in, over, under, across, along, and upon the real estate described and depicted in the Easement Plat attached hereto as "Exhibit A" (hereinafter "Easement Tract").

The aforesaid perpetual rights and easements are granted together with the right: (i) to use reasonable working space adjacent to said Easement Tract during construction or maintenance of said utility systems; (ii) to control the growth of any vegetation, trees, shrubs, or saplings on the Easement Tract; and (iii) to clear and remove, without any liability whatsoever to Grantee, any obstacles on the Easement Tract which interfere or threaten to interfere with the safe and proper construction, operation, and maintenance of any said utility systems on the Easement Tract, or which create hazardous conditions, and to keep the Easement Tract clear of such obstacles and obstructions. Grantee shall have the right to clear and remove any such obstacles, but not the obligation to do so.

Grantee plans to: remove an existing corrugated metal pipe storm sewer and install a new concrete pipe storm sewer, construct an outlet ditch for the storm sewer to the eastern portion of the Easement Tract, remove the existing sanitary sewer and install a new PVC sanitary sewer generally along the same route, and remove certain trees deemed necessary to complete said work, all upon the Easement Tract (hereinafter, the "Utility System Improvements").

Grantee further covenants and agrees to use its best efforts to stabilize any ravine slopes located within the Temporary Construction Easement and Easement Tract which are disturbed during construction of the Utility System Improvements by planting grass seed and installing suitable erosion control mats.

Grantors hereby release and waive all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois. The rights and easements granted herein shall run with the land and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their respective heirs, successors, administrators, and assigns.

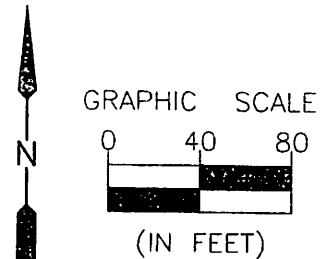
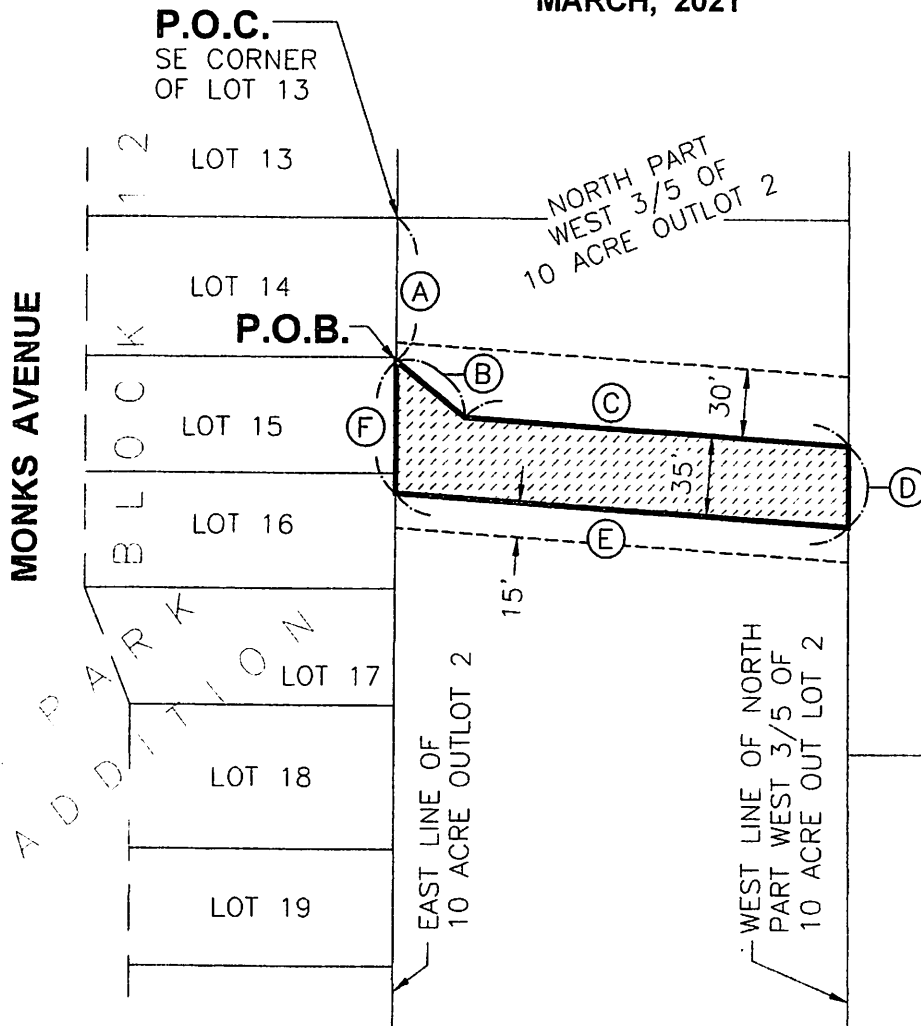

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF PERU

Dear Mr. Bartley and Council:

Stage 212 is requesting use of Centennial Park for an outdoor performance of "Spoon River Anthology" on the following dates:

June 11, 12, 17 from 4:30p - 9:30p

June 13 from noon - 5:00p

June 19 from noon - 9:30p

Our proposal would be to use the shelter that is just east of the bandshell construction. That is where we would access electricity. Our audience would be safely distanced in painted circles going up the hill from there. Patrons will bring their own lawn chairs and coolers. We do not plan to sell any concessions. We will not have any heavy equipment to be parked on the lawn. We will set up a couple of tables to run our sound equipment, etc. We would plan to rope off a special area for our angel patrons and for those with mobility issues. We would also want to reserve a few parking spaces for those with mobility issues and a loading zone for drop-offs. We would ensure that all trash is picked up after each performance, but would rely on using the city garbage cans that are in the park. Those garbage cans would likely need to be emptied after each performance. In addition, we do have liability insurance and can provide a certificate just as soon as our insurance company can draw it up. We can also supply a Covid Safety Plan for the event if necessary.

We are hopeful for around 800 patrons over the course of the performances, but really cannot gauge yet the level of comfort of our patrons to be in crowds and to be outdoors. We have limited the attendance to 300 per performance. Depending on patrons' preferences for dates, we could have small crowds on some nights, bigger on others. We also understand that there will be a city sponsored concert on the 18th between two of our dates.

We believe that our event will benefit the city in that our patrons will likely have dinner, purchase gas, and stop by a convenience store to fill their coolers. We have patrons from all over the area, once introduced to the park, they may later attend city events over the summer. The News Tribune is planning to do a feature article about our event and that would provide the city with some positive exposure in the community at large.

I would like to provide a little background information on our organization. Stage 212 is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit community theatre serving the entire IV area, staffed with hundreds of volunteers. We have been part of this community for more than 50 years. However, we have been shuttered since March of 2020 with no income. This production will not provide us with any additional income either. We are honoring a

season pass that our patrons purchased in the fall of 2019 for the year 2020 in which we were unable to deliver any performances. Tickets are priced at \$15 per production. To be honest, the income from those 2020 season passes is gone. We have spent over \$51,000 just maintaining our building and basic business expenses over the past 15 months. In addition, we cannot plan or sell a 2022 season until we have fulfilled the 2020 season and there basically will be no 2021 season. To be blunt, we are in survival mode, as are so many of our local businesses. Yet, we are confident that we can pull out of this with a little help from our friends.
