All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Aldermen Waldorf asked to table the proposed noise ordinance. Alderman Sapienza concurred and asked to table to at least two weeks.



Petitioner requests that approval of the Final Plat for Master-View Park Subdivision and other requested relief be granted contingent and effective upon the Petitioner's acquisition of the Subject Property and establishment of the MVP TIF District.

Planning/Zoning Commission Members Miller, Atkinson, Lucas, Kalsto, Brady, and Moreno were present at the hearing. Member Grabowski was absent.

We further certify that we have named said plat "Master-View Park Subdivision, City of Peru, Illinois," and have named the roadways as designated thereon and do hereby join and consent to said plat being presented to the City Council of the City of Peru for adoption and having the same recorded as provided by law.

We further certify that all roadways shown thereon and therein contained are dedicated to the City and to the public use and we further release and waive all rights under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois in and to said roadways shown on plat.

The City, for itself, its successors, assigns and permittees, reserves, creates and grants to the City the following perpetual rights and easements in, over, under, across, along, and upon those portions of the plat designated "Utility Easements" (hereinafter "Easement Tracts"):

- a. To construct, operate, repair, maintain, patrol, inspect, relocate, reconstruct and remove, from time to time, electric transmission, distribution and communication lines and systems, including, but not limited to, overhead cables, conduits, conductors, grounds, drains, necessary service pedestals, transformer cabinets, concrete transformer pads, transformer riser poles and conduits, associated overhead supply lines, and other equipment appurtenant thereto and, without limitation, such other installations as may be required or may be deemed necessary by the City for electrical system purposes;
- b. To construct, operate, repair, maintain, patrol, inspect, relocate, reconstruct and remove, from time to time, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and any and all manholes, tiles, pipes, connections, catch basins and, without limitation, such other installations as may be required or may be deemed necessary by the City for sanitary and/or storm sewer purposes; and
- c. To construct, operate, repair, maintain, patrol, inspect, relocate, reconstruct and remove, from time to time, water mains and lines, and any and all necessary manholes, hydrants, pipes, connections, buffalo boxes and, without limitation, such other installations as may be required or may be deemed necessary by the City for water services purposes.

The aforesaid perpetual rights and easements are reserved, created and granted together with the right (i) to use adjacent roads, streets and alleys for such purposes and to use reasonable working space adjacent to said Easement Tracts during construction or maintenance of said utility system; (ii) to control the growth of any vegetation, trees, shrubs, or saplings on the Easement Tracts; and (iii) to clear and remove, without any liability, any obstacles on the Easement Tracts which interfere or threaten to interfere with the safe and proper construction, operation, and maintenance of any said utility system on the Easement Tracts or which creates hazardous conditions, and to keep the Easement Tracts clear of such obstacles and obstructions. The City shall have the right to clear and remove any such obstacles, but not the obligation to do so.

Subsequent owners may make any use of the Easement Tracts, so long as such use does not interfere with the rights herein reserved or create a hazardous condition, except that the subsequent owners shall make no excavations on the Easement Tracts without the prior consent of the City and then only in such manner as will not disturb or interfere with the City's facilities located therein, nor shall the subsequent owners place buildings or structures on the Easement Tracts. Subsequent owners may pave entranceways over the Easement Tracts. Notwithstanding to the contrary in this Easement, the City shall not interfere with any ingress or egress over or upon any roadways on the said Easement Tracts.





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 110-93(a) OF THE CITY OF PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING STOP SIGNS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 110-93(a) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Peru, Illinois, shall be, and is hereby amended to add stop signs at the following locations:

SECTION 2: Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$750.00 for each offense, as provided in the Code of Ordinances.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 102 – TAXATION, ARTICLE II. HOTEL OR MOTEL ROOM RENTAL TAX, OF THE CITY OF PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of Peru, Illinois ("City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, moral and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 102 of the City's Code of Ordinances provides for the imposition of a hotel/motel tax and regulations related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the City and its residents to amend various provisions of Chapter 102 of the City Code of Ordinances as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The City Council finds as fact the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance and incorporates them herein by reference.

SECTION 2: Code Amendment. Chapter 102 – TAXATION, ARTICLE II. – HOTEL OR MOTEL ROOM RENTAL TAX, of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended by adding the underlined provisions and deleting the provisions noted with a strikethrough as follows:

ARTICLE II. HOTEL OR MOTEL ROOM RENTAL TAX

Sec. 102-26. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Gross Rental Receipts means the total amount of consideration for occupancy, valued in money, whether received in money or otherwise, including all receipts, cash, credits, and property or services of any kind or nature, including but not limited to, amounts charged for the making, booking, facilitating or servicing of reservations. Gross rental receipts means both: (a) the "net rate" paid to the hotel or motel by an online travel company for room occupancy by the consumer; and (b) the amount

retained by the online travel company for travel-related services provided to the consumer (sometimes referred to as a "facilitation fee"), and any additional amounts retained by the online travel company as compensation for its travel services to the consumer for the individual transaction, or, in the instance of a consumer's direct rental of a room with the hotel or motel, the gross rental receipts shall mean the amount charged by the hotel or motel directly to the consumer for the occupancy of the room.

Hotel; room and mMotel means any building or buildings, or portion thereof, in which the public may, for consideration, obtain living quarters, sleeping or housekeeping accommodations, including hotels, inns, motels, tourist homes or courts, lodging houses, rooming houses, apartment houses, and short-term rentals. Accommodations within said buildings, which are leased to the same occupant for a period of more than thirty (30) consecutive days, regardless of the initial lease commitment, shall be exempt from the tax provisions of this article. room mean any living quarters, sleeping or housekeeping accommodations in any building in which the public may, for a consideration, obtain living quarters, sleeping or housekeeping accommodations. The term includes inns, motels, tourist homes or courts, lodginghouses, roominghouses and apartment houses.

Owner means any person having a sufficient proprietary interest in conducting the operation of a hotel or motel room or receiving the consideration for the rental of such hotel or motel room so as to entitle such person to all or a portion of the net receipts thereof.

Person means any natural person, trustee, court-appointed representative, syndicate, association, partnership, firm, club, company, corporation, business trust, institution, agent, government corporation, municipal corporation, district or other political subdivision, contractor, supplier, vendor, vendee, operator, user or owner; or any officer, agent, employee or other representative acting either for himself or for any other person in any capacity; or any other entity recognized by law as the subject of rights and duties.

Room; Rooms means any living quarters, sleeping or housekeeping accommodations.

Sec. 102-27. Levied Tax imposed.

(a) There A tax is hereby levied and imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of renting, leasing, or letting rooms in a hotel or motel in the City or making, booking, facilitating or servicing the leasing or renting of rooms in a hotel or motel in the City at a rate of seven percent (7%) of the gross rental receipts from such rental, leasing or letting. the use and privilege of renting a hotel or motel room within the city a tax of five percent of 94 percent of the gross rental receipts from such renting, leasing or letting, excluding, however, from gross rental receipts, the proceeds of such renting, leasing or letting to permanent residents, that is persons staying for at least 30 consecutive days, of that hotel and proceeds from the tax imposed under subsection (c) of section 13 of the Metropolitan Pier and Exposition Authority Act, 70 ILCS 210/13.

- (b) The ultimate incidencet of and liability for payment of such aid tax shall be borne by the person who seeks the privilege of occupying user, lessee or tenant of any such hotel or motel room. Such person is referred to as "renter."
- (c) The tax levied in this section shall be paid in addition to any and all other taxes and charges. It shall be the duty of the owner of every hotel or motel to act as trustee for and on account of the city, and to secure the tax from the renter of the hotel or motel room and pay over to the city treasurer Director of Finance the tax under procedures prescribed by the city treasurer Director of Finance or as otherwise provided in this article.
- (d) Every person required to collect the tax levied by this section shall secure the tax from the renter at the time he collects the rental payment for the hotel or motel room. Upon the invoice receipt or other statement or memorandum of the rent given to the renter at the time of payment, the amount due under the tax provided in this article shall be stated separately on the documents.

Sec. 102-28. Rules and regulations.

The city treasurer Director of Finance may promulgate rules and regulations not inconsistent with this article concerning enforcement and application of this article. The term "rules and regulations" includes, but is not limited to, case-by-case determination of whether the tax imposed by this article applies.

Sec. 102-29. Inspection and examination of books and records.

- (a) The city treasurer Director of Finance may enter the premises of any hotel or motel for inspection and examination of books and records in order to effectuate the proper administration of this article and to ensure the enforcement of the collection of the tax imposed. It shall be unlawful for any person to prevent, hinder, or interfere with the city treasurer Director of Finance in the discharge of his duties and the performance of this article.
- (b) It shall be the duty of every owner to keep accurate and complete books and records to which the city treasurer Director of Finance shall at all times have access, which records shall include a daily sheet showing the following:
 - (1) The number of hotel or motel rooms rented during the 24-hour period, including multiple rentals of the same hotel rooms where such shall occur; and
 - (2) The actual hotel or motel tax receipts collected for the date in question.

Sec. 102-30. Taxation period; filing tax receipts.

- (a) The owner of each hotel or motel room within the city shall file tax returns showing tax receipts received with respect to each hotel and motel room during each month period on the first day of every month on forms prescribed by the city treasurer Director of Finance. The return shall be due on or before the 30th day of the calendar month succeeding the end of the month filing period.
- (b) At the time of filing such tax returns, the owner shall pay to the city <u>treasurerDirector</u> of Finance all taxes due for the period to which the tax return applies.

Sec. 102-31. Delinquency penalty.

If for any reason any tax levied under this article is not paid when due, a penalty at the rate of 1½ percent per 30-day period, or portion thereof, from the day of delinquency shall be added and collected.

Sec. 102-32. Collection.

Whenever any person shall fail to pay any tax as provided in this article, the corporation counsel shall, upon the request of the city treasurer Director of Finance, bring or cause to be brought an action to enforce the payment of such tax on behalf of the city in any court of competent jurisdiction.

Sec. 102-33. Disposition of proceeds and fines.

All proceeds resulting from the imposition of the tax under this article, including penalties, shall be paid into the city treasury and shall be credited to and deposited in the corporate fund of the city.

Sec. 102-34. Suspension or revocation of city licenses for tax evasion.

If the mayor, after a hearing held by or for him, shall find any person has willfully avoided payment of the tax imposed by this article, he may suspend or revoke all city licenses held by such tax evader. The owner, manager or operator of the hotel or motel shall have an opportunity to be heard at such hearing to be held not less than five days after notice of the time and place of the hearing to be held is given to him, addressed to him at his last known place of business.

Sec. 102-35. Penalty.

- (a) Any person found guilty of violating, disobeying, omitting, neglecting or refusing to comply with or resisting or opposing the enforcement of any of the sections of this article, except when otherwise specifically provided, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to punishment as provided in section 1-19.
- (b) The purpose of imposing the penalties in subsection (a) of this section is to ensure the integrity of the collection process established pursuant to this article.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50 – HEALTH AND SANITATION, ARTICLE II. NOISE, SECTION 50-32. EXEMPTIONS, OF THE CITY OF PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of Peru, Illinois ("City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is advisable and in the best interests of the City to amend the City of Peru Code of Ordinances to clarify the regulations and considerations for issuance of permits for outdoor events which provide certain exemptions from the City noise ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The City Council finds as fact the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance and incorporates them herein by reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: <u>Code Amendment.</u> Chapter 50 – HEALTH AND SANITATION, ARTICLE II. – NOISE, Sec. 50-32. Exemptions., Subsection (5) of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended by adding the underlined provisions and deleting the provisions noted with a strikethrough as follows:

Sec. 90-39. - Exemptions.

Sounds caused by the following are exempt from the prohibitions of this article and are in addition to the exemptions specifically set forth in this article:

- (5) Other outdoor events. Outdoor gatherings, public dances, shows, parades, concerts, festivals, and other similar outdoor events, provided that permission has been authorized by the superintendent of public works. a permit approved by the city council has been obtained from the city council. Permits shall be issued on a case by case basis in the exercise of appropriate reasonable discretion considering all factors deemed pertinent to the particular application for permit, including, but not necessarily limited to, the following:
 - a. The location applicable to the respective permit and the surrounding community;
 - b. The decibel level exception, if any, being requested in regard to the permit application;
 - c. The time frame involved in the respective permit;
 - d. Whether an alternative date has been requested;
 - e. The past history of the applicant, including, but not limited to, being in regard to any prior specific event permit; and
 - f. Such other factors as the city council deems appropriate in the exercise of reasonable discretion.

The city council shall also have the discretion in regard to any permit application to set such parameters and/or restrictions in regard to the granting of any such permit as are deemed

appropriate in the exercise of reasonable discretion. Additionally, in regard to the denial of any permit application and/or a portion thereof, the respective applicant may appeal any such denial pursuant to the pertinent provisions of review of administrative decisions pursuant to the Illinois Administrative Review Act of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 3: If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
