Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Planning/Zoning Commission of the City of Peru, IL, on Wednesday, the 2nd day of November, 2022, at the hour of 5:00 p.m. in the City Municipal Building, 1901 Fourth Street, Peru, IL, at which time and place the Planning/Zoning Commission will consider the Petition for Annexation and Zoning submitted by Michael A. Leone, Trustee under a Trust Agreement dated August 28, 2020 and known as the Michael A. Leone Revocable Living Trust; James J. Leone and Linda J. Leone, Co-Trustees under a Trust Agreement dated January 28, 2013; and Leone Grain & Supply, Inc. ("Petitioners) concerning certain real estate generally located east of Plank Road and north and south of Peru Rail (formerly the LaSalle and Bureau County Railroad) in unincorporated LaSalle County, Illinois (collectively, the "Territory"), legally described as follows:
