A regular meeting of the Peru City Council was called to order by Mayor Ken Kolowski in the Peru City Council Chambers on Monday, May 22, 2023, at 7:08 p.m.

City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno present; Mayor Kolowski present.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

PUBLIC COMMENT

PRESENTATION

Amy Lambert, Executive Director of Illinois SBDC at The Starved Rock Country Alliance addressed the council to report there are 104 new businesses since 2017 with \$12.1 million in funding. Ms. Lambert also reported 350 jobs created with 154 of which are full-time positions.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS/ACTIVITY REPORTS

Mayor Kolowski presented the Regular Minutes of May 8, 2023 and Peru Police Department Monthly Report for April 2023. Alderman Payton made a motion the minutes and reports be received and placed on file. Alderman Sapienza seconded the motion; motion carried.

Alderman Sapienza made a motion the disbursements be received, placed on file and the bills be paid in the usual manner. Alderman Tieman seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Tieman made motion to approve \$4,000 donation to Peru Boys Little League. Alderman Edgcomb seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Tieman made a motion to approve \$4,000 donation to Peru Girls Softball League. Alderman Edgcomb seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE

Alderman Ballard made a motion to approve quote from Lazinski Cement Finishing Co. in the amount of \$10,818.00 for repairs to curb and driveway approaches on 15th Street, due to a water main break. Alderman Lukosus seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Lukosus made a motion to award bid from Powercon, in the amount of \$3,408,809.00 for switch gear for the Center Street Substation. Alderman Ballard seconded the motion. Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning reported on the 100-week lead time. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Council tabled the motion to approve proposal from Vipower Services in the amount of \$226,383.00 to evaluate SCADA system and to provide proposal for replacement.

Alderman Sapienza made a motion to approve quote from Peru Greenhouse, in an amount not to exceed \$10,000, for trees at roundabout. Alderman Edgcomb seconded the motion. Alderman Moreno made a motion to approve purchase of a 2016 GMC Sierra 1500 from Jeff Perry in the amount of \$28,500 for the parks department. Alderman Lukosus seconded the motion. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert presented a proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING OFFICE HOURS FOR THE CITY OF PERU CLERK'S OFFICE

Clerk Bartley reported he requested the change to link up the administration's hours, in an effort to support each other the best they can. Clerk Bartley stated that with COVID, there was a move away coming into the office all the time to do your business, so we still have the opportunity to pay a bill by the phone, by the website, or drop box. Alderman Payton stated he the clerk's office is the entry point to the City of Peru and if they don't know who to talk to or they need something they don't go to the police, they go to the clerk's office. Alderman Lukosus suggested altering the schedules or staggered schedule to allow cover until 5pm. Aldermen Sapienza said he was concerned about safety of having one person in the building at a time. Clerk Bartley stated he wouldn't set us up where one person close would close the building, noting there would be some risk involved. Mayor Kolowski concurred. Alderman asked about foot traffic after 3:30 p.m. and likes the idea of the administrative team working the same schedule. Council discussed possibility of revisiting the change if the panel got some "pushback" from the public. Alderman Edgcomb made a motion the ordinance be adopted as written and read. Alderman O'Sadnick seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick Lukosus voting aye; Alderman Payton and Moreno abstained; motion carried.

Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert presented a proposed ordinance entitled:

Alderman Edgcomb made a motion the ordinance be adopted as written and read. Alderman Tieman seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

[For discussion or action] AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF SHORT-TERM RENTALS

Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert provided the council with a rough draft of a proposed ordinance for the aldermen to review. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert stated other communities were struggling with regulating short-term rentals and the ordinance requires time and effort. Mayor

Kolowski asked the aldermen to review it before returning to the next council meeting. Alderman Edgcomb stated Peru has several properties listed on rental property websites that are not zoned or authorized in the city and asked if the council planned to notify the owners. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert told the council he had some cease-and-desist letters drafted for residents who were operating those rental properties. Corporate Counsel stated it's not fair that these people that petition to come through try to do everything properly while others continue to operate and stated he has reached out to Airbnb to see if the city could get an agreement in place for the collection of the hotel-motel tax. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert stated that's something that in this ordinance he would like to see done because that removed a lot of our enforcement work. They'd be required to make sure the people that are hosting properties on their site are registered with the city and remove those listings that are not. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert stated he hasn't been able to get a hold of anyone with Airbnb and that is one of the reasons he asked for the council to table the discussion. Alderman Sapienza agreed and stated Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert should send out the cease-and-desist letters to those operating. Alderman Sapienza stated we have laws, rules and we need to abide by them. Mayor Kolowski stated the whole point of the conversation is there are no regulations on short-term rental properties and the council needs to do their homework on the issue.

Alderman Lukosus made a motion the petition be received, placed on file and referred to the Planning/Commission for review and recommendation. Alderman Moreno seconded the motion; motion carried.

Clerk Bartley presented a petition from Steve Michelini requesting annexation and approval of a final plat subdivision for property located between Plank Road and Meridian Road. Alderman Lukosus made a motion the petition be received, placed on file and referred to the Planning/Commission for review and recommendation. Alderman Moreno seconded the motion; motion carried.

Closed session began at 8:17 p.m. and ended at 9:45 p.m.

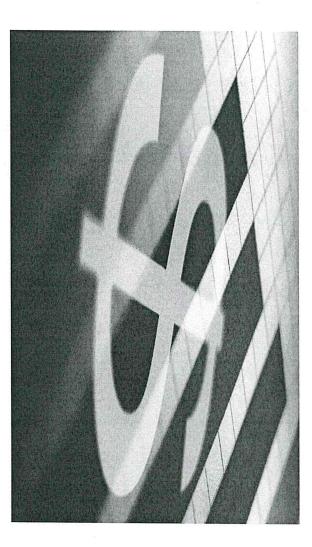

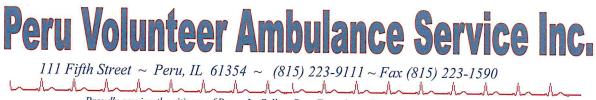

The Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service responded to two hundred fifteen (215) patient/calls during the month of April. The two hundred fifteen (215) patient/calls included one hundred thirty-six (136) emergencies for Peru, four (4) emergencies for Dimmick, zero (0) emergencies for Peru Township, and sixty-three (63) transfers. Of the one hundred forty (140) emergencies, eighty-eight (88) patients were transported, forty-six (46) patients refused treatment, three (3) were disregarded, and three (3) were Stand-by requests.

Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. responded to three (3) Mutual Aid requests with La Salle Fire/EMS, four (4) Mutual Aid requests with 10/33 Ambulance Service, one (1) Mutual Aid requests with Utica Ambulance, one (1) Mutual Aid request with PC-EMS, one (1) Mutual Aid request with Cedar Point Ambulance, and two (2) Motor Cross Standby requests.

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The total mileage logged was 5893 miles for the month of April.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to legal notice published in the News Tribune in the manner provided by law, the Planning/Zoning Commission of the City of Peru convened for a public hearing on Wednesday, May 31, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Municipal Building, 1901 Fourth Street, Peru, IL, to consider the Petition of Bill and Kathy Vohs ("Petitioners") concerning property commonly known as 2511 Rock Street in the City of Peru, Illinois, legally described as follows:

Lot Forty-two (42) in Marquette Manor Third Addition to the City of Peru, according to the plat thereof recorded February 19, 1965 in Plat Book X at Page 34, except coal and other minerals underlying said premises and the right to mine and remove the same, in La Salle County, Illinois, and subject to easements, covenants and restrictions of record.

PIN #: 17-09-317-005 ("Property")

Petitioners desire to construct a detached patio roof and shade pergola in the rear yard of the Property and request the following relief under the City's Zoning Ordinance, to wit:

- (2) For such other and further relief deemed necessary and appropriate.

The Property is zoned R-2 Single Family Detached Dwelling Residence District

Planning/Zoning Commission Members Miller, Lucas, Kalsto, Grabowski, Brady, Jones, and Becker were present at the hearing. No Members were absent.

Petitioners appeared and were duly sworn. Mr. Vohs testified that they have a paver patio in the rear yard of the Property separated about 2' from the house by a gravel area. The structure will be supported by six 6" x 6" posts, half of which will be set in the gravel area. Referencing the design shown in the

attached photograph, Mr. Vohs said half of the structure will be for shade, with 2" x 6" boards placed at 16" centers topped by 2" x 2" boards. The other half of the structure will be covered with a metal roof. Mr. Vohs explained the reason for that is to meet the gable and avoid interfering with electric service line. The shade structure will be well below that service line.

In response to questioning from Chairman Miller, Mr. Vohs said the photograph does not depict the actual design of the proposed structure, but it will be very similar. The structure will not be attached to the Petitioners' house. It will be about 2" from the gutter. In response to further questioning from Member Lucas, Mr. Vohs confirmed the gable of his house goes the opposite direction of that shown in the photograph.

Mr. Vohs testified further that his contractor, Greg Coble, indicated the 6" x 6" posts will be set in 10" wide holes, 4' deep, and filled with concrete. If there is any give to the structure, he would reinforce it with angled supports or metal brackets as shown in the photograph.

In response to questioning from Chairman Miller, City Director of Engineering and Zoning Eric Carls said that his office did not have any comments and offered a recommendation of support for the Petition.

City Corporation Counsel Scott Schweickert stated that upon his review, the only concern he had was with fire separation. Attorney Schweickert said the reason for the minimum distance separating accessory structures from the primary residence is so that fire does not spread. Schweickert noted that the Petition included photographs and drawings of a fire pit near the proposed structure but did not identify the distances separating them.

Mr. Vohs testified that the fire pit is 10' away from the structure. Attorney Schweickert said that 10' separation is typically the standard set forth in the building codes. Mr. Vohs explained further that the firepit is centered in the middle of a 10' diameter paver patio, which patio will then be separated several feet away from the proposed structure. The fire pit will be at least 10' away from the first 6" x 6" post.

There were no public comments or objections.

The Planning/Zoning Commission found the requested relief will not alter the essential character of the locality; will not be detrimental or injurious to other properties in the area; will not impair an adequate supply of light or air to adjacent properties, or increase the danger of fire, or endanger the public safety, or diminish or impair property values and will not increase street congestion and, therefore, favorable recommends that the City Council grant the relief as prayed for in the Petition.

Member Grabowski moved, and Member Kalsto seconded, to favorably recommend the City Council approve the Petition as prayed for. The motion passed unanimously: 7 aye, 0 nay, and no Members absent.
