A regular meeting of the Peru City Council was called to order by Mayor Ken Kolowski in the Peru City Council Chambers on Monday, June 19, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

City Clerk Dave Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno present: Mayor Kolowski present.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident Roger Clark voiced his opposition to daily rentals and enforcement. Corporate Counsel Scott Schweickert replied with the following:

PRESENTATION

MINUTES/FINANCIAL REPORTS/ACTIVITY REPORTS

Mayor Kolowski presented the Regular Minutes of June 5, 2023 and the Peru Police Department Monthly Activity Report for May 2023. Alderman Payton made a motion the minutes and reports be received and placed on file. Alderman Ballard seconded the motion; motion carried.

Alderman Tieman made a motion to approve Memo of Agreement with IBEW Local 51. Alderman Sapienza seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Alderman Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Payton made a motion to approve quote from The Cincinnati Insurance Company though Dimond Bros Insurance for the city's Boiler and Machinery coverage in the amount of \$120,843.00 and noted a 6% increase. Alderman Tieman seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Tieman made a motion to approve invoice from Illinois Valley Area Chamber of Commerce (IVAC) in the amount of \$3,000.00 (annual membership). Alderman Payton seconded the motion. Mayor Kolowski stated the membership is a good investment for the city, especially now. Mayor Kolowski complimented IVAC Executive Director Bill Zens for his outstanding efforts regarding the hospital situation Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Ballard made a motion to approve invoice from NCICG in the amount of \$2,968.80 (annual membership). Alderman Tieman seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Alderman Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Finance Officer Tracy Mitchell reported the auditors were here and performed their preliminary tests and will be back mid July.

PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE

Alderman Payton made a motion to approve change order for squad 325. Original estimate \$33,693.49, change order for cracked block, new amount is \$45,289.06. Alderman Edgcomb seconded the motion. Alderman Ballard noted that it was good that the crack block was identified and we will now have a two year warranty. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

Alderman Edgcomb made a motion to approve a proposal from P&D sign for a new sign above the scoreboard at Washington Park in the amount of \$12,000.00 (JA Happ field naming). Adam Thorson stated there will be an end-of-season ceremony for Peru Little League Baseball and Softball on July 30th at 2pm and honor the outstanding career of J.A. Happ. Alderman Edgcomb suggested having a cookout for the kids. Mr. Thorson stated he would reach out for food donations. Alderman Payton seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Payton, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; motion carried.

PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE

Eric Carls, Director of Engineering and Zoning initiated a discussion regarding sanitary sewer extension (as part of the annexation agreement) to the Illinois Valley Auto Group. Mr. Carls stated the city will extend a main from Tim Perra Drive to the Illinois Valley Auto Group. Mr. Carls noted that as part of the IEPA permit application form, the city has to identify that the project with not have any private or special funding involved. Mr. Carls stated the project with be done with all local funds. Alderman Lukosus made a motion to approve the discussion. Alderman O'Sadnick seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Aldermen Ballard, Tieman, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; Alderman Payton absent; motion carried.

Alderman Ballard made a motion to approve the lease and maintenance contract Standard Equipment. The maintenance agreement is \$95,000.00. The lease is not to exceed \$398,951.88 (included trade in). Alderman Lukosus seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Alderman Ballard, Tieman, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; Alderman Payton absent; motion carried.

Alderman Sapienza made a motion to approve the execution of an agreement with Ferguson Enterprises, LLC for cloud-based water meter installation software. Fees based on the number of meters installed, \$15.00 per meter plus \$750.00 for on-site training. Alderman O'Sadnick seconded the motion. Clerk Bartley called the roll with Alderman Ballard, Tieman, Edgcomb, Sapienza, O'Sadnick, Lukosus and Moreno voting aye; Alderman Payton absent; motion carried.

The Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service responded to two hundred sixteen (216) patient/calls during the month of May. The two hundred sixteen (216) patient/calls included one hundred fifty-four (154) emergencies for Peru, four (4) emergencies for Dimmick, eight (8) emergencies for Peru Township, and thirty-seven (37) transfers. Of the one hundred sixty-six (166) emergencies, ninety-five (95) patients were transported, fifty-six (56) patients refused treatment, ten (10) were disregarded, and four (4) were Stand-by requests.

Peru Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. responded to five (5) Mutual Aid requests with La Salle Fire/EMS, three (3) Mutual Aid requests with Mendota Fire/EMS, one (1) Mud 5K Run Standby request, and four (4) Motor Cross Standby requests.

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The total mileage logged was 5281 miles for the month of May.

WHEREAS, on or about April 21, 2023, M2K of Chicago, LLC d/b/a Annie's Pancake House ("M2K") purchased the Subject Property from Weisbrod, L.L.C., and intends to operate a restaurant thereon that will continue to utilize the licensed outdoor patio seating area; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a Right-Of-Way Encroachment License Assignment and Consent Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein ("Agreement"), to assign the License from Weisbrod, L.L.C. to M2K; and

RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENT LICENSE ASSIGNMENT AND CONSENT AGREEMENT

THIS RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENT LICENSE ASSIGNMENT AND CONSENT AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is entered into as of July _____, 2023, by and between the City of Peru, an Illinois home-rule municipal corporation ("City" or "Licensor), and M2K OF CHICAGO, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, d/b/a "Annie's Pancake House" ("M2K" or "Licensee").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2021, the City of Peru duly passed and adopted Resolution No. 2021-16, entitled: "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY ENROACHMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH WEISBROD, L.L.C. D/B/A MARK ALLEN'S AMERICAN KITCHEN (1402 PEORIA STREET)"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, the City executed a Right-Of-Way Encroachment License Agreement on August 16, 2021, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" (the "License") granting Weisbrod, L.L.C. the right to encroach on the City's right-of-way for purposes of serving restaurant patrons under a covered, outdoor patio seating area at the property commonly known as 1402 Peoria Street in Peru ("Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, on or about April 21, 2023, M2K purchased the Subject Property from Weisbrod, L.L.C., and intends to operate a restaurant known as "Annie's Pancake House" that will continue to utilize the licensed outdoor patio seating area; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to transfer the License from Weisbrod, L.L.C. to M2K.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the mutual covenants and obligations contained in this Agreement and the License, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. **Defined Terms.** Capitalized terms used in this Agreement and not otherwise defined in this Agreement shall have the meanings given to such terms in the License.
- 2. Consent; Assignment. City hereby consents to the transfer and assignment of the License from Weisbrod, L.L.C. to M2K, and M2K hereby accepts the assignment and agrees to assume all the rights, duties and obligations of Weisbrod, L.L.C. under the License.
- 3. Notices. Any Notice required or permitted under the License shall be in writing and shall be sufficient if personally delivered or mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:

- **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute a single instrument.

RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT

This Right-of-Way Encroachment License Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made and entered into at Peru, Illinois this 16 day of August, 2021, by and between the City of Peru, an Illinois home-rule municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and Weisbrod, L.L.C., an Illinois limited liability company, d/b/a Mark Allen's American Kitchen. The License herein granted shall be subject to all existing utility easements, if any, located within the City Right-Of-Way, or any other easements, conditions, covenants or restrictions of record.
- 3. *Term.* This Agreement and the License granted to Licensee hereunder shall commence as of the date of this Agreement and shall continue thereafter until terminated at any time by the City, with or without cause.

- 7. Limited Scope of License. The License granted to Licensee is limited in scope to the use of the right-of-way for a covered, outdoor seating patio area.
 - Licensee shall not have the right to expand the right-of-way or alter or change Licensee's use of the right-of-way without the City's prior written consent. Licensee agrees to comply with all the provisions of the City Code of Ordinances.
- 8. Transferability of License. The License granted to Licensee by this Agreement is a privilege granted by the City to Licensee and is neither transferable nor assignable by Licensee without the City's prior written consent.

Licensee shall perform under this Agreement in accordance with all applicable legal requirements.

 - a. Damage to Licensee's Property. Any and all claims, loss or damage (including reasonable attorney's fees) to the Licensee's Property or any property belonging to or rented or licensed by Licensee, its officers, servants, agents or employees, which may be stolen, destroyed, or in any way damaged, by any cause whatsoever.

Any claims, suits, judgments, costs, attorney's fees, loss, liability, damage or other relief, including but not limited to workers' compensation claims, to any person or property in any way resulting from or arising out of the existence of this Agreement and/or the existence, maintenance, use or location of the Licensee's Property and improvements within the City Right-Of-Way. 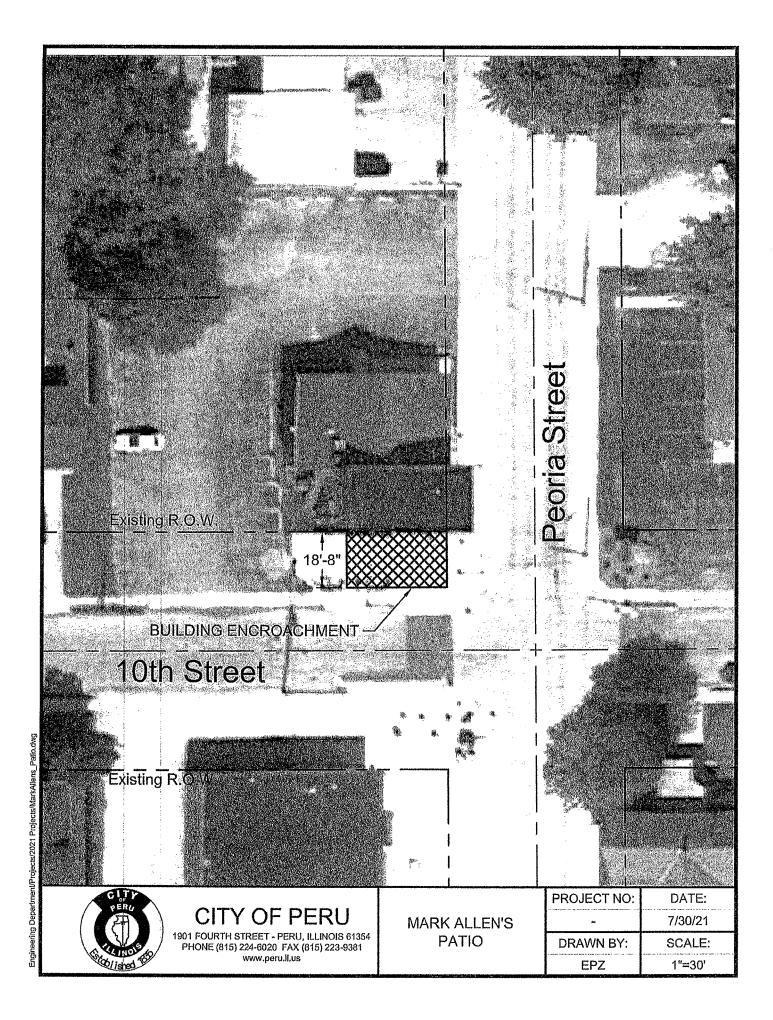

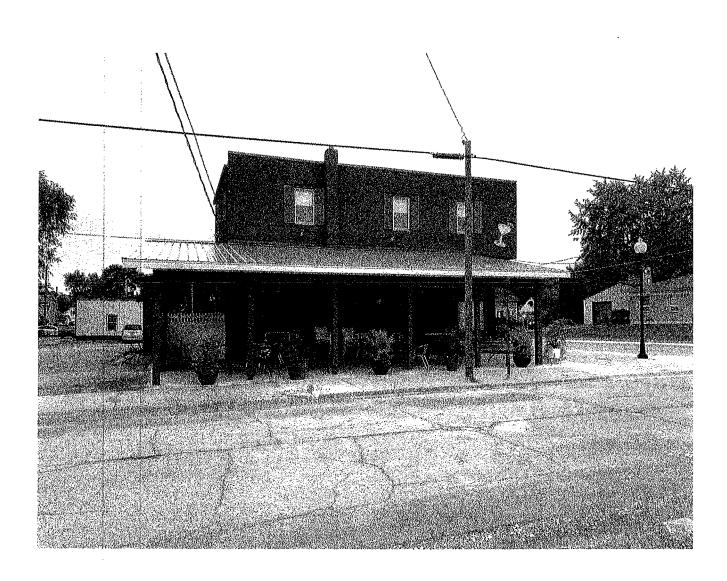

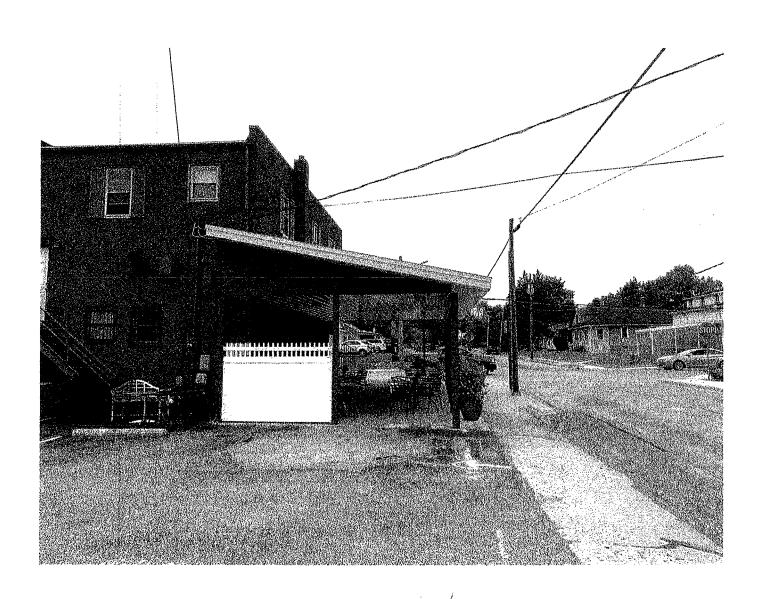

- 17. *No Personal Liability*. No official, director, officer, agent or employee of the City shall be charged personally or held contractually liable under any term or provision of this Agreement, or because of their execution, approval or attempted execution of this Agreement.
- 18. Joint and Collective Work Product. This Agreement is and shall be deemed and construed to be a joint and collective work product of the City and Licensee, and as such, this Agreement shall not be construed against any other party as the otherwise purported drafter of the same by any court of competent jurisdiction in order to resolve any inconsistency, ambiguity, vagueness or conflict, if any, in the terms or provisions contained herein.
- 19. *Severability*. The terms of this Agreement shall be severable. In the event any of the terms or provisions of this Agreement are deemed to be void or otherwise unenforceable, for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 20. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois. Venue for the resolution of any disputes or the enforcement of any rights arising out of or in connection with this License agreement shall be in the Circuit Court for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, La Salle County, Illinois.
- 21. *References in Agreement*. All references in this Agreement to the singular shall include the plural where applicable, and all reference to the masculine shall include the feminine and vice versa. If either reference shall be declared invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining portion that shall remain in full force and effect.
- 22. *Multiple Counterparts*. This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- 23. *Paragraph Headings*. Paragraph headings are inserted for convenience only and in no way limit or define the interpretation to be placed upon this Agreement.
- 24. *Binding Agreement on Parties*. This Agreement shall be binding on the parties hereto and their respective successors and permitted assigns.
- 25. *Entire Agreement*. This Agreement and its exhibits constitute the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes any prior agreement or understanding relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.
- 26. *Modification*. This Agreement may be changed, modified or amended only by a duly authorized written instrument executed by the parties hereto. Each party agrees that no

representations or warranties shall be binding upon the other party unless expressed in or writing herein or in a duly authorized and executed amendment hereof.

27. *Authority of the City*. This Agreement is authorized pursuant to Section 94-4 of the City of Peru Code of Ordinances.

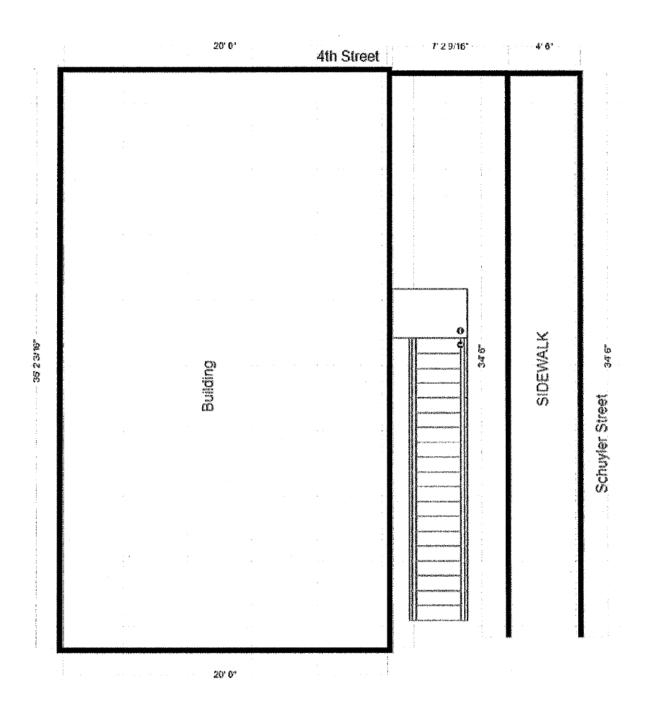

AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of ______, 2023, by and between the City of Peru, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation ("City"), and Twin Towers LTD, an Illinois limited liability company ("Twin Towers").

WHEREAS, Twin Towers is the owner of record of certain real estate property commonly known as 248 LaSalle Road, Peru, Illinois (LaSalle County PIN# 17-04-211-005) ("Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is not situated within the limits of any municipality but is contiguous to the City and within the City's 1 ½ mile extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Twin Towers maintains a billboard structure ("Billboard") upon the Subject Property which advertises an adult use business; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code authorizes the City to contract with individuals, associations, and corporations in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the City to remove the Billboard at the City's cost and expense, and Twin Towers is agreeable to the City's removal of the Billboard.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the City and Twin Towers hereby agree as follows:

- 1. *Billboard Removal*: Twin Towers grants the City the right to enter upon the Subject Property for the sole purpose of removing the entire Billboard (advertising surface and telephone poles). The City shall bear all costs and expenses associated with the Billboard's removal, including but not limited to labor, equipment, and restoration of the Subject Property to its previous condition, as reasonably practical.
- 2. Access and Coordination: Twin Towers shall provide reasonable access to the Subject Property to allow the City and its authorized contractors or agents to perform the removal of the Billboard. The City shall coordinate with Twin Towers to schedule the removal of the Billboard at a mutually agreed-upon time and date.
- 3. *Indemnification*: The City agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Twin Towers, its officers, directors, employees, and agents from and against any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, or expenses arising out of or related to the removal of the Billboard, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Twin Towers.
- 4. *No Compensation*: Twin Towers acknowledges and agrees that it shall not be entitled to any compensation or reimbursement from the City or any other party for the removal of the Billboard.

- 5. *Entire Agreement*: This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the City and Twin Towers relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, and agreements, whether oral or written.
- 6. *Governing Law*: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois with venue being proper only in the Circuit Court of the 13th Judicial Circuit, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- 7. Severability: If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
