ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110 – TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, OF THE CITY OF PERU CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF BICYCLES, LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES, SNOWMOBILES, AND PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Peru is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1, provides that the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-80-2, grants to the City the power to regulate the use of streets or other municipal property; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-1518(a) of the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-1518(a), empowers the City to authorize and regulate the operation of low-speed electric scooters within the City on any or all highways, sidewalks, trails or other public right-of-way where the operation of bicycles is permitted; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Ordinance to permit and regulate the operation of low-speed electric scooters under the broader category of personal mobility devices within the corporate limits of the City as authorized by Section 11-518(a) of the Illinois Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, it is further the intent of this Ordinance to permit and regulate the operation of bicycles and low-speed electric bicycles in the City pursuant to the above authority and the City's home rule powers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: City Code Amended. Chapter 110 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES), ARTICLE III. (OPERATION OF VEHICLES), Sec. 110-63. (Toy vehicles on roadways; skateboards) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Peru, Illinois shall be and is hereby deleted and marked “Reserved”.

SECTION 3: City Code Amended. Chapter 110 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES), ARTICLE VII. (BICYCLES, SNOWMOBILES, INLINE SKATES, ROLLER SKATES AND SKATEBOARDS) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Peru, Illinois shall be and is hereby replaced in its entirety with a new ARTICLE VII, entitled: “BICYCLES, LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES, SNOWMOBILES, AND PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES”, which shall read as provided on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 4: Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All ordinances, resolutions and policies or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of the conflict, expressly repealed on the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

SECTION 6: Publication; Effective Date. The clerk is directed by the corporate authorities to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/1-2-4.

CHAPTER 110 – TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**ARTICLE VII. - BICYCLES, LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES, SNOWMOBILES,
AND PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES**

DIVISION 1. – GENERALLY

Sec. 110-401. - Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this Article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Bicycle means every device propelled by human power upon which any person may ride, having two tandem wheels, except scooters and similar devices.

Downtown Business District means the following areas within the City:

- (a) Fourth Street between Calhoun Street and West Streets; and
- (b) Fifth Street between Pulaski Street and Peru Street.

Low-speed electric bicycle means a bicycle equipped with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than 750 watts that is not a moped, motor driven cycle, minibike or pocket bike; and meets the requirements of one of the following classes:

- (a) "Class 1 low-speed electric bicycle" means a low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 miles per hour.
- (b) "Class 2 low-speed electric bicycle" means a low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 miles per hour.
- (c) "Class 3 low-speed electric bicycle" means a low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 28 miles per hour.

Low-speed electric scooter means a device weighing less than 100 pounds, with 2 or 3 wheels, handlebars, and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding, that is solely powered by an electric motor and human power, and whose maximum speed, with or without human propulsion, is no more than 10 miles per hour. "Low-speed electric scooter" does not include a moped or motor-driven cycle.

Personal assistance mobility device means manual wheelchairs, power wheelchairs, electric scooters and manually powered mobility aids such as a walkers, crutches, cane, braces, and other similar devices used by a person with a disability.

Personal mobility device means an electric-powered or electric-assisted device designed to transport only one person with an electric propulsion system of less than 750 watts and that limits the maximum speed of the device to ten (10) miles per hour or less, including a low-speed electric scooter as defined in Section 1-140.11 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/1-140.11, as amended, and a motorized or motor-assisted skateboard, or any other similar devices. The following shall be exempt from this definition: (1) personal assistance mobility devices as defined below; (2) personal mobility devices used by the United States Postal Services to deliver United States mail; and (3) personal mobility devices used by governmental entities for public safety purposes or by a City employee in the performance of the employee's official duties.

Shared-use path means the paved pathway located within a public easement or upon the City's right-of-way and other City-owned property that has been designated as the "shared-use path" by the City for use by pedestrians, bicycles, low-speed bicycles, personal mobility devices, and certain other devices as permitted in accordance with this Article.

Skateboard means a device with two (2) or more tandem axles and a combination of wheels connected by a platform designed for standing and which is propelled by human power.

Skates means any device worn on the foot with wheels and which is propelled by human power. This definition includes devices commonly known as roller skates, in-line skates, roller blades, and similar devices.

Snowmobile means a self-propelled device designed for travel on snow or ice or a natural terrain steered by wheels, skis or runners and supported in part by skis, belts, or cleats.

Sec. 110-402. – Duty of parent or guardian.

It shall be unlawful for any parent or guardian to permit any minor child seventeen (17) years of age or younger of which they are a parent or guardian to violate any provisions of this Article.

Sec. 110-403. – Penalty.

Any person who violates a provision of this Article shall be punished by a fine of not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) nor more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00). A separate offense shall be deemed committed for each day on which a violation occurs or continues.

Secs. 110-404—110-420. - Reserved.

DIVISION 2. – BICYCLES, LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES, AND PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES

Sec. 110-421. – Obedience to traffic laws and traffic-control devices.

Any person operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device shall be granted all of the rights, and be subject to all of the duties, applicable to the driver of a vehicle as set forth in Chapter 11 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11), including, but not limited to, obedience to official traffic signals, signs, and other traffic control devices applicable to vehicles unless otherwise directed by a police officer.

Sec. 110-422. – Operation of bicycles, low-speed electric bicycles, and personal mobility devices.

(a) *Safe Operation:* A person shall, at all times, operate a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, and personal mobility device with due regard for the safety of the operator and other persons and vehicles lawfully upon any streets, highways or other public places.

(b) *Riding on bicycles, low-speed electric bicycles, and personal mobility devices:* A person operating a bicycle or low-speed electric bicycle shall not ride other than upon or astride the permanent and regular seat attached thereto, nor carry any other person or persons upon such bicycle or low-speed electric bicycle other than upon a firmly attached and regular seat designed and intended for such purpose. No bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device shall be used to carry more than one (1) person unless specifically designed and equipped for more than one (1) person. A bicycle rider eighteen (18) years of age or older may carry a child securely attached to their person in a backpack, sling, bike trailer, child seat, or other similar device.

(c) *Speed:* No person shall operate a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the then existing conditions.

(d) *Riding on right:* Every person operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device upon a public street or roadway shall ride as near to the right side thereof as practicable, exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

(e) *Emerging from alley or driveway:* The operator of a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device emerging from an alley, driveway or building shall, upon approaching a sidewalk or sidewalk area extending across any alleyway, yield the right of way to all pedestrians and other persons operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, personal mobility device, or personal assistance mobility device approaching on said sidewalk area and upon entering the public street or roadway, shall yield the right of way to all vehicles and other persons operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, personal mobility device, or personal assistance mobility device approaching on said street or roadway.

(f) *Emerging from shared-use paths:* Any person operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device upon a shared-use path shall yield the right of way to all vehicles, pedestrians, and other persons operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, personal mobility device or personal assistance mobility device prior to riding into a sidewalk area extending across any intersecting roadway or a roadway if there is no sidewalk area, as applicable.

(g) *Clinging to vehicles:* No person riding upon any bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device shall attach said bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device, or themselves, by clinging or otherwise, to any other vehicle.

(h) *Riding in a group:* Persons operating bicycles, low-speed electric bicycles, or personal mobility devices in a group shall ride in single file.

(i) *Carrying articles:* No person operating a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, and/or personal mobility device shall use a handheld cell phone or similar device, or carry any package, bundles, or articles which prevent the person from keeping both hands upon the handlebars and under the operator's control. The operator of a bicycle, low-speed electric bike, and/or personal mobility device with handlebars shall always keep at least one hand on the handlebars at all times.

(j) *Parking:* No person shall park a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device upon a public street other than upon the roadway against the curb or upon the sidewalk in a rack to support the bicycle or against a building or at the curb in such a manner as to afford the least obstruction to pedestrian traffic.

(k) *Parking in Downtown Business District.* No person shall park a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device upon the roadway or adjacent sidewalk in the Downtown Business District except in bicycle racks provided for such purposes. Any person who is in violation of this subsection shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25).

(l) *Other devices prohibited:* Electric bicycles other than low-speed electric bicycles, or devices that do not meet the definition of a personal mobility devices due to being equipped with a motor of 750 watts or more, or capable of a maximum speed in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour, shall not be permitted to be operated on any public right-of-way or on any other public property within the City.

(m) *Duty to signal:* Before turning or changing the direction of any bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle or personal mobility device upon any street or public way, it shall be the duty of the operator to give a signal, by an extension of his hand, to indicate the direction the operator intends to proceed.

(n) *Low-speed electric scooters age restriction:* A person under the age of eighteen (18) may not operate a low-speed electric scooter.

(o) *Class 3 low-speed electric bicycle age restriction:* It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of sixteen (16) to operate a Class 3 low-speed electric bicycle on any street, highway, or roadway as set forth in Section 11-1517(h) of the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-1517(h), as amended.

Sec. 110-423. – Location restrictions.

(a) *Downtown Business District:* Bicycles, low-speed electric bicycles, and personal mobility devices may be operated on any sidewalk in the City except upon sidewalks within the Downtown Business Districts. Any person who rides or operates a bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device on a sidewalk in a Downtown Business District in violation of this section shall not be an intended and permitted user of such sidewalk pursuant to Section 3-102(a) of the Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act, 745 ILCS 10/3-102(a), as amended.

(b) *City Parks:* It shall be unlawful to ride upon or operate any bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, or personal mobility device within the confines of any park, except upon shared-use paths and designated parking areas.

(c) *Low-speed electric scooters prohibited on State highways:* A person may not operate a low-speed electric scooter or other personal mobility device on any State public highway in the City as set forth in Section 11-1518(k) of the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-1518(k), as amended. State highways within the City include, but are not limited to: Interstate 80, Illinois Route 251, Illinois Route 6, and May Road east of Illinois Route 251.

(d) *Low-speed electric scooters prohibited on roadways with shared jurisdiction:* Unless allowed by the laws and regulations of the City of LaSalle or other applicable public body sharing jurisdiction with the City over a roadway, no person shall operate a low-speed electric scooter upon any roadway under shared jurisdiction. Shared jurisdiction roadways include, but are not limited to: Airport Road, Peru Street, Wenzel Road east of Marquette Road, Shooting Park Road west of Sycamore Street.

(e) *Personal Mobility Devices Restricted Upon Certain Roadways.* A person may not operate a personal mobility device upon any roadway with a posted speed limit in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour outside a crosswalk.

Sec. 110-424. – Equipment.

(a) *Lamps and reflectors:* Every bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, and personal mobility device operated at nighttime shall be equipped with a lamp on the front which shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred feet (500') to the front and with a red reflector on the rear which shall be visible from all distances from one hundred feet (100') to six hundred feet (600') to the rear when directly in front of lawful lower beams of headlamps on a motor vehicle. A lamp emitting a steady or flashing red light visible from five hundred feet (500') to the rear may be used in addition to or instead of the red reflector.

(b) *Brakes:* Every bicycle, low-speed electric bicycle, and personal mobility device shall be equipped with a brake which will enable the operator to adequately control movement of and stop and hold such bicycle, low-speed electric bicycles, or personal mobility device.

Secs. 110-425—110-430. - Reserved.

DIVISION 3. – SNOWMOBILES

Sec. 110-431. – Adoption of the Illinois Snowmobile Registration and Safety Act.

All provisions of the Illinois Snowmobile Registration and Safety Act, 625 ILCS 40/1-1 *et seq.*, are hereby adopted by reference, the same as if all such provisions were set out in full in this Article.

Sec. 110-432. - Prohibited operation.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a snowmobile under any of the following circumstances:

- (a) In violation of the Illinois Snowmobile Registration and Safety Act, 625 ILCS 40/1-1 *et seq.*
- (b) Upon public school grounds, public rights-of-way, park property, playgrounds, recreational areas or other publicly owned land.
- (c) In a manner so as to create loud, unnecessary or unusual noise so as to disturb or interfere with the peace and quiet of other persons.
- (d) In a careless, reckless or negligent manner so as to endanger the safety of any person or the property of any other person.

Sec. 110-433. - Operation on streets impassable by other vehicular means.

Notwithstanding other sections of this division, a person may operate a snowmobile on streets which are impassable by other vehicular means due to snow and ice only if necessary for provision of food and shelter and to provide transportation for those furnishing essential services, including, but not being limited to, doctors, nurses, police officers, firefighters and employees of public utilities.

Secs. 110-434—110-440. - Reserved.

DIVISION 4. – TOY VEHICLES, SKATES, SKATEBOARDS AND OTHER SIMILAR DEVICES

Sec. 110-441. - Prohibited use.

It shall be unlawful and no person shall operate, ride, or use a toy vehicle, skates, skateboard, or other similar devices upon:

- (1) Any roadway other than at a crosswalk;
- (2) Any sidewalk or public area within the City’s Downtown Business Districts;
- (3) Any public or private property where a sign has been posted prominently on the property prohibiting the use of such devices; or
- (3) Any place in the City in such a manner as to be dangerous to persons or property.

Sec. 110-442. - Reflective clothing required at night.

No person shall operate, ride, or use a toy vehicle, skates, skateboard, or similar device on any public right-of-way or public property in the City during the nighttime after sunset and before sunrise without wearing reflective clothing or reflective items. Such reflective clothing shall be adequate to reflect brightly the headlights from a motor vehicle, and the wearer shall have at least one item of reflective clothing visible from in front and one visible from in back. In lieu of any item of reflective clothing, the wearer may wear any device or decoration that is adequate to reflect such lights brightly.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A HIGHWAY
AUTHORITY AGREEMENT WITH WENDY FULMER CONCERNING
ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION OF PROPERTY AT 1501 36TH
STREET, PERU, IL**

WHEREAS, the City of Peru (“City”) is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Wendy Fulmer (“Owner/Operator”) is the owner and/or operator of one or more leaking underground storage tanks presently of formerly located at 1501 36th Street a/k/a Wenzel Road, Peru, IL (“the Site”); and

WHEREAS, as a result of one or more releases of contaminants from the Site, soil and/or groundwater contamination at the Site exceeds the Tier 1 residential remediation objectives of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 742; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Operator is conducting corrective action in response to the releases of contaminants; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Operator and the City desire to prevent groundwater beneath the City’s right-of-way that exceeds Tier 1 remediation objectives from use as a supply of potable or domestic water and to limit access to soil within the right-of-way that exceeds Tier 1 residential remediation objectives so that human health and the environment are protected during and after any access; and

WHEREAS, the Owner/Operator and the City desire to enter into a Highway Authority Agreement (“HAA”), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, entering into the HAA with Owner/Operator is a matter pertaining to the government and affairs of the City, is for a proper public purpose, and is in the best interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERU, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The City Council finds as facts the recitals hereinbefore set forth and incorporates them herein by reference.

SECTION 2: Authorization. The Mayor and City Clerk, and each of them, for and on behalf of the City, are hereby authorized and directed to execute the HAA.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval according to law.
